A Pap test is a screening procedure that can find changes in the cervix before cancer develops, or in its early, most curable stage.

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What You Need to Know



A pelvic exam is an examination of the female reproductive organs to check for infections, cancer, and other conditions. A Pap test is a common screening done during a pelvic exam to help detect cervical cancer.

The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists recommends women start having cervical screenings at age 21. Screenings should occur every three years for women ages 21-29.

Women ages 30-65 should have a Pap test and an HPV test (co-testing) every five years. It is acceptable to have a Pap test alone every three years.
