



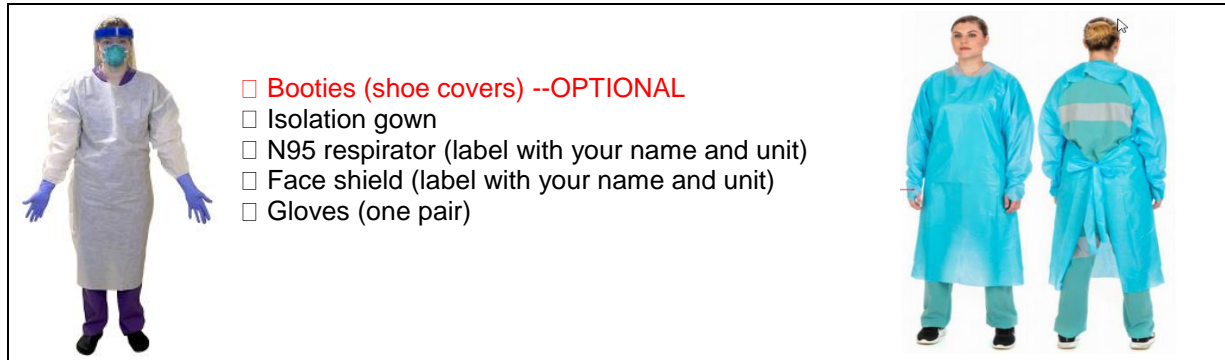
## COVID-19 Donning Sequence – N95 & Booties Version

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

This version includes the optional use of booties (shoe covers). If you decide to use booties for COVID-19 care, careful adherence to the provided hospital protocol must be followed – as it may increase risk of self-contamination with COVID-19.

### **Supplies Required:**



### **Isolation Room Type:**

- For isolation rooms with anteroom –
  - You may don gown and gloves inside or outside of the anteroom.
- For isolation rooms without anteroom –
  - You will don gown and gloves outside of the room.

### **Donning Sequence:**

#### **Hand hygiene:**

- Perform hand hygiene.

#### **Booties (shoe covers):**

- Don booties (may need to sit on chair for safety) – *ensure proper fit for safe ambulation*
- Perform hand hygiene.

#### **Gown:**

- Inspect gown and make sure there are no tears.
- Don gown, place thumbs through the holes and tie in the back.

#### **N95 & face shield:**

- Don N95 respirator - top strap goes on top backside of head, bottom strap goes on bottom backside of head, and adjust over your nose.
- Perform the “breathing” test/fit check to ensure mask seal is good.
- Don face shield.

#### **Gloves:**

- Don gloves over the gown sleeves.

*You are now ready to enter the patient's room.*
