

COVID-19 VACCINE – Patient information for providers and employees**HPH TO BEGIN O'AHU COVID-19 VACCINE CENTER FOR ADULTS OVER 75 AND CERTAIN OCCUPATIONS**

Hawaii Pacific Health, like all other health care organizations in Hawaii, is following the state's COVID-19 Vaccination Plan and federal government mandates for distribution of the vaccine to priority groups based on their risk of exposure.

The plan now allows us to offer COVID-19 vaccination to people ages 75 and older. We have set up a vaccination clinic, at Pier 2 in downtown Honolulu that will serve people who qualify by age or by occupation.

The HPH COVID-19 Vaccination Center will be open as follows:

Monday through Saturday, beginning on Jan. 18, 2021
8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
Pier 2 Cruise Terminal
521 Ala Moana Boulevard

Vaccinations are available by appointment only. Walk-ins will not be accepted. Attached is a sample of the confirmation **flyer** the patient will need to bring to their appointment.

Patients who have a MyChart® by Hawaii Pacific Health account will be sent a notification through MyChart where they can sign up for an appointment. Please see **chart** on the patient population we are currently working with as well as screenshots of sample patient **emails**.

As additional vaccine doses are received in the coming weeks and months, it will become available to more people based on the designated priority groups. Although we don't have control over the prioritization, please be assured that we will work to provide more information to you as quickly as we are able to.
