

COVID-19 VACCINE – Patient information for providers and employees

WILCOX TO BEGIN COVID-19 VACCINE CENTER FOR ADULTS OVER 75

Hawai'i Pacific Health, like all other health care organizations in Hawai'i, is following the state's COVID-19 Vaccination Plan and federal government mandates for distribution of the vaccine to priority groups based on their risk of exposure.

The plan now allows us to offer COVID-19 vaccination to people ages 75 and older. We have set up a vaccination clinic, in Conference Rooms B/C and the main lobby that will serve people who qualify by age.

The Wilcox COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic will be open as follows: Friday, Jan. 15 – 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 19 – 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 21 – 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday, Jan. 22 – 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Vaccinations are available by appointment only. Walk-ins will not be accepted.

Patients who have a MyChart® by Hawai'i Pacific Health account will be sent a notification through MyChart where they can sign up for an appointment. Please see chart on the patient population we are currently working with as well as screenshots of sample patient emails.

If your patients do not already have an MyChart® account, please encourage them to create one online at MyChart.HawaiiPacificHealth.org, as it will be the easiest way to schedule an appointment. See MyChart sign up instructions included.

As additional vaccine doses are received in the coming weeks and months, it will become available to more people based on the designated priority groups. Although we don't have control over the prioritization, please be assured that we will work to provide more information to you as quickly as we are able to.
