PPE for Labor and Delivery

Non-Pushing (First Stage)

Adopt the higher level of protection if rule out or confirmed COVID patient and contact will be within 6 feet for more than 10 minutes.




Headgear remains on health care worker through multiple patients (i.e., do not replace per patient)

If splashes/sprays are anticipated, full face shield should be worn.

- Fresh gloves for all patient contact. Gown for contact/droplet precaution.
- Break back tie in order to don gown over head gear.
- Proper hand hygiene.
