
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REMINDER: 2021 QPP/SSP REVIEW PERIOD

Eligibility for credit is based on a projected provider performance ≥50% of the provider's total possible QPP/SSP points for 2022. HHP will be reaching out to providers who may qualify in September to complete attestation forms. So please start early and utilize the Dashboards to track your progress!



HMO REFERRAL UPDATE

HHP Managed Care Services has recently discontinued the use of our HHP HMO Referral Request forms. All out-of-network referrals for HMSA HMO patients will be processed and reviewed within the Epic system:

- EXTERNAL REFERRAL ORDERS: Referrals will automatically fall into the HHP HMO External Referral Workqueue when an External Referral Order is placed for an HMSA HMO patient. An Epic in-basket message will be sent to the referring provider's office if the referral is identified as out-of-network.
- EPIC IN-BASKET REQUEST: Providers and clinic staff are able to submit requests for out-of-network utilization review to HHP Managed Care (pool) via In-basket message. Smartphrase .HHPREFERRALREQUEST should be utilized when submitting for review.

Central Support UPDATE

Central Support is now available to be utilized by all HHP PCPs on O'ahu and Kaua'i. These core member services include care coordination support, complex care management, managed care support for referral management and network resources, and the production and analysis of population health and quality performance data.

Central Support services was recently expanded to include our PCPs at the various Straub Medical Center and Kaua'i Medical Clinic primary care clinics.

Central Support continues to provide support for BH Referrals, DME Orders/Supplies and Network Access.
